



TRACK DAYS GENERAL CONDITIONS

Join the regulars on track days and find a new and exciting side to your BMW— motorsport pedigree. It's not all about speed though; the track is the perfect place to learn about your own and your car's limits and feel more confident behind the wheel.

Please Note:- We do need you to reply a minimum of four (4) days prior to the event to enable scheduling and catering. Also so the chef knows how much to cook!

Location: Baskerville Raceway

Start Time: 10.00am for a 10.30am start

Driver Briefing: 10.15pm (compulsory for all drivers)

Finish Time: 3.30pm approx

Cost: (2011 year – subject to change) \$130 per car paid in cash, or cheque on the day. Cheques to be made out to 'Motorsport Tasmania Pty Ltd'. If you are a member of a Baskerville Shareholder Club (CMI, HSCC, Mini Car Club) then the fee is only \$80.

All drivers must pay and sign (passengers to only sign) the Motorsport Tasmania Pty Ltd's indemnity form before driving on the circuit. All passengers must also sign the indemnity form, as it is entirely the drivers decision to participate and drive on the circuit and the BMW Car Club of Tasmania Inc. bears no liability.

You will not need any sort of CAMS licence. You are hiring the track time as an individual directly from Tasmanian Motorsport Pty Ltd. The **BMW Car Club of Tasmania Inc.** has no responsibility or liability over who drives or participates as we are not formally booking the track for our sole use. It is the individual driver who enters and drives at his/her own risk.

Your car is likely to be un-insured on the track. Check with your individual insurance company should you be concerned about driving on the track.

Vehicles must be road registered and all drivers licensed. You must have at least a learners permit.

Generally a maximum of five cars will be allowed on the track at any one time.

If there are motorbikes or open wheel race cars attending and using the track on the day, then they will have their own track time. Usually this mean there will be track sessions of about 30 minutes each.

Track Access:

No vehicles or persons are to cross the track while there are cars circulating. Please wait at the track-side security gate until the track is clear and you will be told when it is safe to cross. Wait times can be as much as 30 minutes. To avoid this wait arrive before the advertised commencement time. Persons may enter the pit area via the footbridge only, while cars are circulating.

Safety:

A helmet that complies with the Australian Standards is compulsory. Non flammable clothing which includes cover from wrists to throat to ankle is required. Suitable footwear - thongs, high heel shoes, roman sandals and the like are prohibited. During any track event, consumption of alcoholic beverages in the paddock, or pits is expressly forbidden until all activities are concluded for the day.

If there is any need to stop cars from circulating while on the track then a red flag will be waived and all cars must return to the pits at the end of that lap.

Vehicle Preparation:

You do not need to do much, but a couple of things will ensure your cars reliability and an enjoyable day. Ensure you remove anything that might move or slide around and don't forget to check the boot. Ensure all the cars fluids are topped up especially the engine oil. Do not expect to get through the day if your brake pad light is on, fit some new brake pads first. If you are going to use your car with road tyres, then inflate them to at least 40psi. It will not hurt the tyres and it will make the car feel a lot more secure on the track.

Eats:

BBQed sausages and bread will be provided free along with drinks for club members on presentation of their membership card. Otherwise it is \$1 per sausage or drink.

Questions:

A **BMW Car Club of Tasmania Inc** authorized member acting a *TRACK DAY COORDINATOR* will be there on the day to carry out the driver briefing and answer any questions. There are always people around with advice on driving and car set-up.
